### **Does my child need \$?:**

Yes, we will be stopping for Dinner Friday evening and lunch on the way home Sunday. All other meals will be provided and are included in the \$75 registration fee. We will also be providing lots of snack food, however you are welcome to bring any snacks you prefer for yourself.

### **What to bring:**
